## General Description:

Supporting the Arts with Voicethread: a voicethread is a collaborative multimedia online slide show that holds images, documents, and videos and allows people to view content and leave comments. Come and explore the logistics of capturing student work with digital cameras, document cameras, audio recording, and video recording. You will also learn how to export work from programs such as ComicLife, KidPix, Microsoft Publisher, Corel WordPerfect or Presentations, Photoshop, etc. as an image and upload to a voicethread. If possible, please bring electronic student work samples to the first session (e.g., digital photos, scans, or video recordings). This series of workshops is most suited to junior and intermediate teachers, however, primary teachers are welcome to join us too.

## Teachers will:

- explore using voicethread (<http://voicethread.com>) with their students to support their work in teaching the arts (drama, dance, music, and visual arts);
- create a (free) voicethread account and comment on the voicethread of other participants in the workshop;
- learn how to upload images and/or videos to a secure website which the students can then access and comment on with voice or text; and
- focus on the general arts curriculum expectations of presenting, reflecting, responding, and analyzing.
