CRITERIA AND CONDITIONS

Honorary Life Membership in PETL may be granted to an individual who has retired from the education profession and who has given outstanding service to the Federation at the Local level. The recipient(s) shall be recognized at the Awards Dinner on Thursday, May 22nd, 2008.

CRITERIA

The **Honorary Life Award(s)** may be granted to an individual who:

- a) has retired from the education profession; and;
- b) has given outstanding service to the Federation at the Local level or as a member of the Local ETFO staff in roles that may include but are not limited to the following: Local Executive Member, Local Committee Member, Local Workshop Presenter, PETL Member appointed to represent PETL in an outside organization or any other activity which has contributed to the advancement or the well-being of the PETL.

PROCEDURES

1. Nominations will be made by members or the Executive on the nomination form attached. **Nomination forms must be received no later than Friday, February 29th, 2008 at 6435 Edwards Blvd., Units 5 & 6, Mississauga, Ontario L5T 2P7 c/o Awards Committee.**
2. The applications are processed by the PETL Awards & Recognition Committee and the Committee's recommendations are taken forward to the PETL Executive for consideration.
